Call for Papers

The Asia Pacific has continued its economic growth with India and China leading the way. However corruption remains as one of the major problems in the region. Bribery, political interference for personal gain, money laundering and capital flight are just some of the aspects of corruption in the Asia Pacific region. This special issue encourages the submission of articles that delve into the corruption that affects administration and/or governance in either the public or private sectors and anti-corruption strategies that have been developed to combat corruption. Submissions for the special issue could be in the following areas.

- comparative studies
 - cross-cultural
 - private vs. public
- anti-corruption strategies
 - policies and procedures
 - legislation
 - effectiveness
- country/organisational analysis
 - political impact
 - economic impact
 - social impact

However, this list does not preclude submissions falling within the broader corruption spectrum existing in the region. Article could be either theoretical or empirical dealing with issues relevant to the focus of the special issue.

Papers submitted for this special issue must be based on original material and not under consideration by any other journal. Authors of papers not selected for the special issue may be selected to be published in another issue of the journal.

Paper Procedure:

The deadline for submissions is August 1st, 2007. All papers will initially be screened by the editorial desk and authors will be notified by 15 August if their papers have not been accepted for review. Papers accepted for review will go through a double blind review process.

The special issue publication date is December 2007 (*JOAAG*, Vol 2, No. 2).
